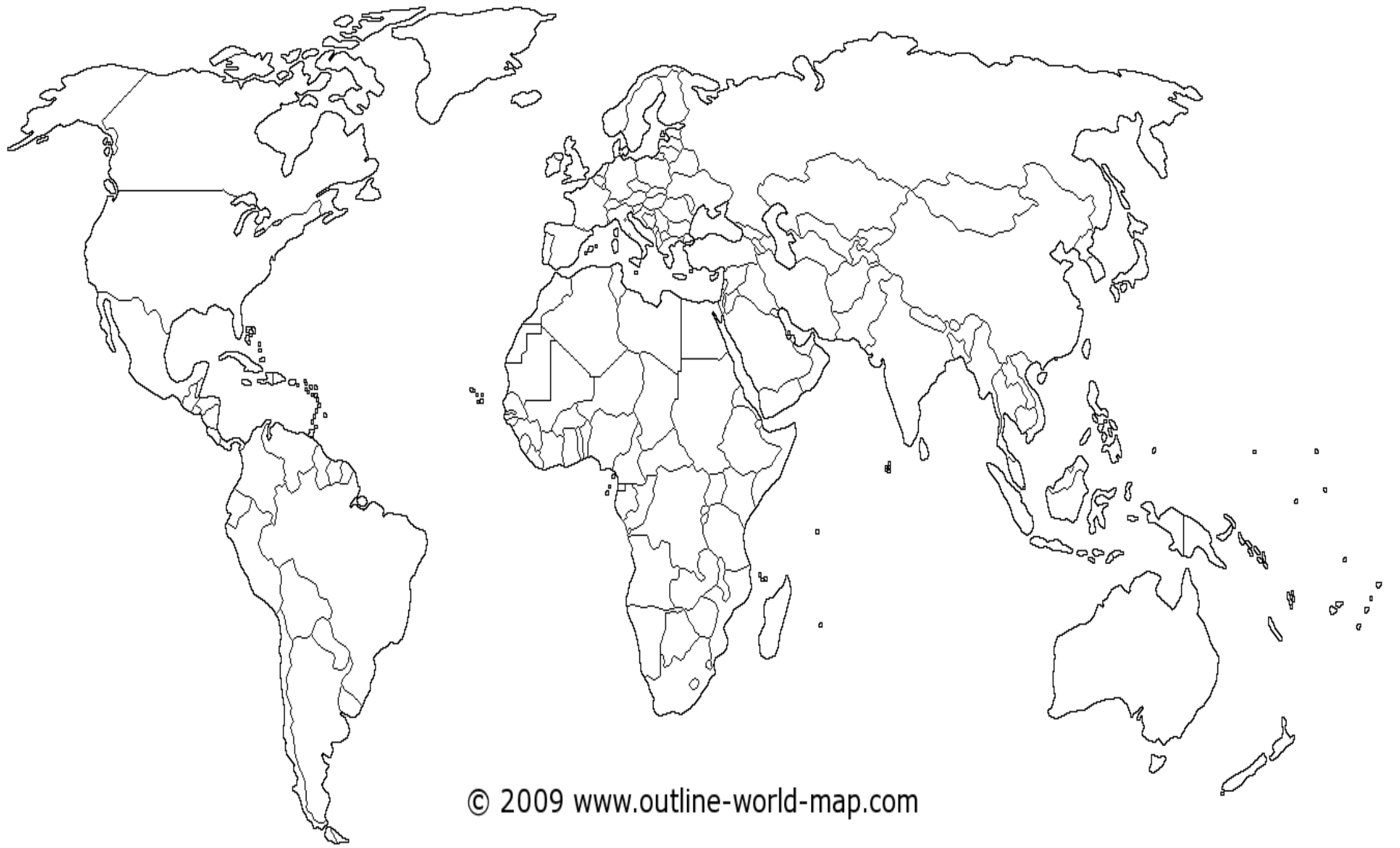

Next, use a map of the world, either the ones that have been provided or one from the internet to mark on the blank world map the following –

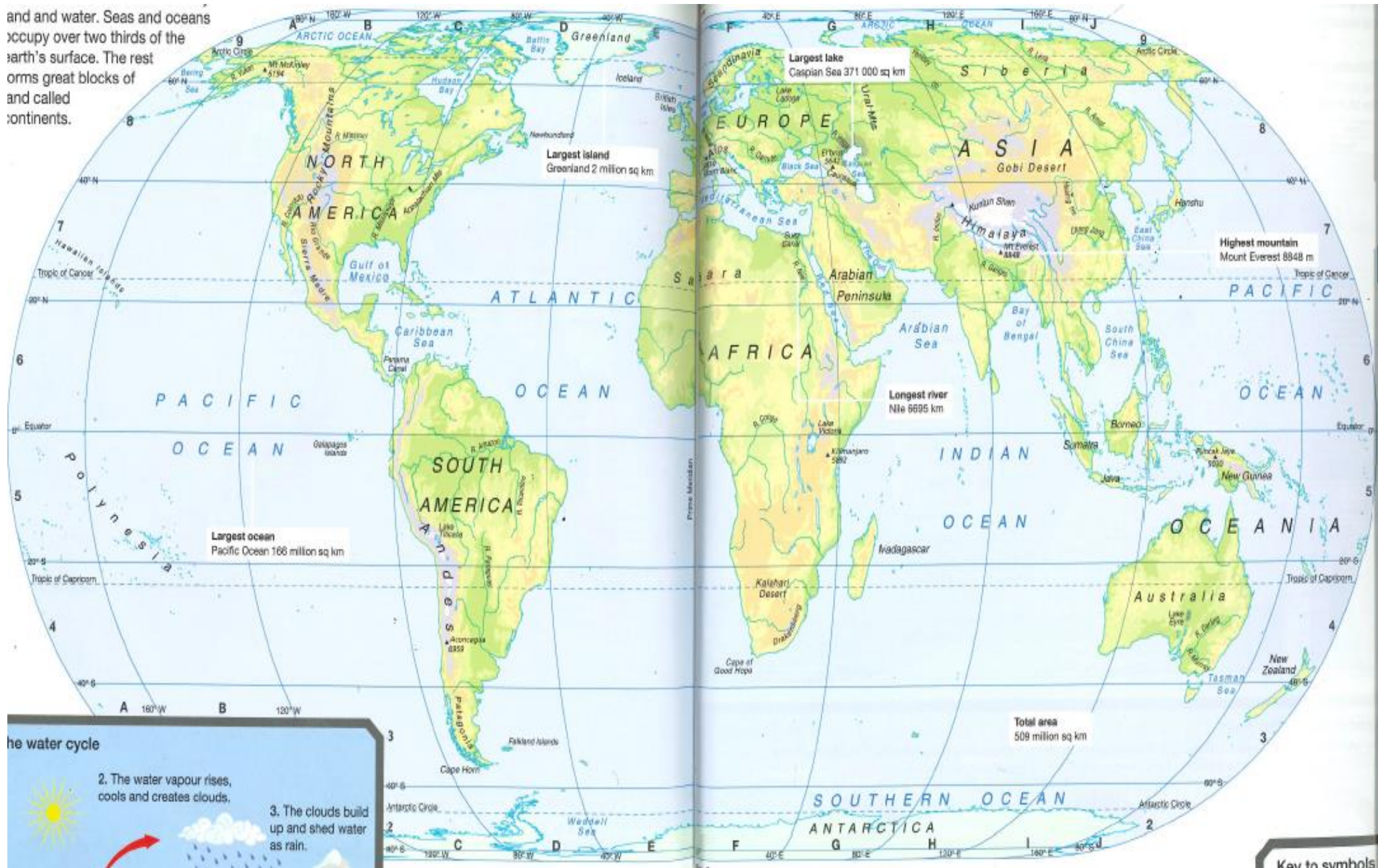
- North, East, South and West.
