We are really excited to be able to offer online live lessons and hope to see as many children as possible joining in. As next week will be the first time that we have tried to do this, we ask that you bear with us and let us know should you have any problems accessing the lessons. For safeguarding reasons, we would ask you to follow the below protocols when accessing the live lessons:

Zoom protocols for live remote learning lessons

School staff will:

- Start the zoom lessons on time and allow access for those wanting to join
- Ensure that children either working in the classroom or at home are not visible on any recording
- Monitor the chat function to ensure questions asked by those working at home are answered in a timely manner

Parents will:

- Aim to join the zoom lesson on time (otherwise teachers may not see that you are waiting)
- Use a display name consisting of the child's first name and their class e.g. Ben 5F
- Ensure children are appropriately dressed, ready to learn and supervised at all times
- Ensure the microphone is muted unless the teacher has asked you to unmute
- Use the chat function to ask any questions.

This timetable details when the live zoom lessons will be held for reading, writing, maths and geography - the zoom link is the same for each of these lessons. You will also notice there is a remote learning support session. This is a dedicated time for you to come online and ask any questions you may have about the remote learning that has been provided for this week. There will also be a class novel read live twice each week and a live PE session with Mr Kay every Friday which we would love as many children to join in with as possible - there are different zoom links for these sessions.
