As a school we have devised some basic rules for when we use zoom for live lessons to ensure everybody stays safe. Please make sure you have read them and have shared them with your children. This is our first week trialling the live lessons so please bear with us!

### Zoom protocols for live remote learning lessons

#### **School staff will:**

- Start the zoom lessons on time and allow access for those wanting to join
- Ensure that children either working in the classroom or at home are not visible on any recording
- Monitor the chat function to ensure questions asked by those working at home are answered in a timely manner

#### **Parents will:**

- Aim to join the zoom lesson on time (otherwise teachers may not see that you are waiting)
- Use a display name consisting of the child's first name and their class e.g. Ben 5F
- Ensure children are appropriately dressed, ready to learn and supervised at all times
- Ensure the microphone is muted unless the teacher has asked you to unmute
- Use the chat function to ask any questions.

Lesson recordings will also be available on the Beechwood Junior School youtube channel at the end of every day if your child would prefer to watch them recorded.
